



PRIVACY POLICY

Our commitment

At What She Did Next, we understand the importance of protecting your privacy and any personal information you may share with us.

We are committed to handling your personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Commonwealth) and the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs).

Personal information

Personal information is information that identifies you or could identify you. During your dealings with us, we may collect personal information such as your name, email address and any other details you may provide in relation to our products and services.

This information may be collected when you subscribe to receive information from us, take part in our surveys or contact us via the website, email, phone, social media or other apps.

Using our website

When you visit any website, it may store information on your browser, mostly in the form of cookies. Cookies are small pieces of data sent from a website and saved on your browser or device. They can be placed by us (What She Did Next or “first party” cookies) or by other companies (third party cookies).

Use of information

Security of personal information

Your personal information is stored in a manner that reasonably protects it from misuse and loss, and from unauthorised access, modification or disclosure.

Maintaining the quality of your personal information
